Park and Trail Hosting Responsibilities:

Each park or club in the network will be responsible for its own trail patrolling and routine maintenance. Trails must meet TrailPass, LLC minimum safety requirements, be properly signed.

Other Trail Hosting responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Researching and securing signed landowner permission
- Researching proper trail positioning in relation to wetlands, or other prohibited areas
- Clearing trails of fallen trees, limbs, branches and natural overgrowth
- Purchase and proper Installation of bridges, culverts and stone
- Repair of minor erosion or trail surface damage
- Purchase and hanging of trail signage
- Trash cleanup

Be advised that TrailPass, LLC **requires** volunteers using power tools or equipment on the trail to be a minimum of 18 years of age. Trail Patrols must also be a minimum of 18 years old.

For safety reasons, TrailPass LLC also requires that all work parties consist of at least two people.

Rider Code of Conduct:

Too often a club or group of riders is falsely judged based on the bad behavior of one or two riders. The future of the sport and our ability to provide the riding community with quality riding areas is directly dependent on your conduct out on the trails. Don't be that one person who gives us all a bad rap. Ride responsibly, be courteous and assume responsibility for your actions.

We have made a short list of TrailPass, LLC safety and conduct **requirements** that will help keep your organization on the right track.

- Always ride within your limits, the limits of your machine and the limits of the trail.
- Helmets are **REQUIRED**. Full safety gear including gloves, a long sleeve shirt or jersey and boots are highly recommended.
- Keep your machine in top shape. Tires, brakes and cables should be inspected every time you ride.
- Consult your owners' manual and comply with the safety standards set forth for your machine.
- Make sure that your machine complies with all local and State requirements.
- Only one rider per vehicle. (Unless the machine is specifically designed for two-up riding or has an approved seat). Consult your owners' manual for seat configurations.
- Ban the Booze!! NO ALCOHOL is permitted on the trails or in any riding area.
- Be courteous to other riders.
- Be respectful to trail patrols and local law enforcement.
- Stay on the posted trails at all times.
- Ride single file on the trails.
- Follow posted speeds.
- Do not be destructive, to the land or to the animals that inhabit the land.
- Be respectful of creek crossings.
- Be especially respectful to the landowners who allow us to recreate on their property.

If you see a rider(s) breaking any of the above rules of conduct - report it to the proper authorities immediately.

Competitions and Racing:

Be advised that participation in the TrailPass LLC Commercial General Liability Policy, available to you under our affiliation program, DOES NOT cover your organization for racing or timed competitions of any kind. If you choose to have a race or timed event on your trail it is YOUR responsibility to provide us with the details of this event. It is also YOUR responsibility to secure and provide payment for event coverage for the type of event that you have chosen.

If you are having an event and are not sure if it is a covered event, it is YOUR responsibility to contact us for clarification.
