Games ATVers Play!!!

The following is a list of games, competitions and events that can be easily incorporated into any Rally or Club Fun Day. The Games are geared towards family fun and can be enjoyed by all Club members irrespective of their vehicle, age or skill level. For a successful event, make sure that the games; the site and the people involved in running the games are adequately prepared ahead of time. Particular attention must be paid to the placement and containment of the spectators.

Keyhole – Set up a 12ft circle with tires or cones etc. Set up a circle 9 ft wide around it leaving room for an entrance. Using a start/finish line, drive into the outer circle and around the inner circle returning to the start/finish line. **Timed event.**

Round Robin – Set up a number of cones (5 or more) in a rough circle. Start at the line going clockwise, circle each cone and return to the starting line. For each bumped or missed cone add two points. To make it even more challenging.... place a tennis ball on top of the cones and assign a point value to them as well. **Fun event.**

ATV Soccer – Using the ATV, move a ball (the larger the better) from the start to finish lines. People are not allowed to touch the balls themselves. The first person and their ball to cross the line wins. This can be done individually, in groups or as a relay race. **Timed Event.**

Poker Run – During a Rally/Ride, have 5-7 predetermined spots where the riders can pick up a poker chip, or get a registration card stamped. At the finishing point, every rider who completed at least 5 stops draws a poker hand. (If they went to all 7 stops, they get to discard 2 cards.) The best hand or worst hand, depending on how you spin the game wins! **Fun Event.**

Dice Run- Runs in the same fashion as a Poker Run, only you roll dice at the end of the event. Most clubs just add up the numbers for a high or low total. **Fun Event.**

Joust – Hang five rings from five trees or whatever is available. The Driver drives from tree to tree while the Passenger tries to collect all five rings with the end of a broom and then return to the starting line. Fastest time with all the rings is the winner. **Timed Event.**

Blind Serpents – Set up a number of cones in a straight line at different spacing intervals. At the starting line, the Driver is blind folded and the passenger must direct the driver to weave through the cones out and back without hitting them. Add points for each cone hit. Make the game more fun by placing tennis balls on top of the cones for additional point value! **Fun Event.**

Egg & Spoon – The passenger is given an egg on a spoon to hold in his mouth. He must keep the egg on the spoon while the driver races from the starting line to the finish line. Make the course as long and as wide as possible – long means it will be harder, and wide means more people can race at the same time. **Timed event.**

Egg & Spoon Non Timed- The passenger is given an egg on a spoon to hold in his mouth. The passenger must keep the egg on the spoon while the driver steers through a tight obstacle course. Add points each time the egg is dropped. **Fun Event.**

Water Carry- Place a glass full of water on the front rack of each participating quad. Have the riders steer through a tight obstacle course. The ATV with the most water left in the glass at the end of the course wins. **Fun event.**

Mud Bog- Dig a long deep trench, (deepest at the far end) add water to make really thick, gooey mud. The object of this game is to get as far as you can through the mud. The rider who gets the farthest wins the event. (Note: If there are a lot of entrants, attach a tow strap to each vehicle before they enter the pit and have a vehicle designated to tow each person back out.) The object here is to dig a pit that is impassable, by making it deeper the farther in that you go. **Fun Event.**

Log Pull- Competitors attach a large log to the back of their quad with a tow strap. They pull this log through a coned course with out hitting the cones. Points are added for each cone hit. (Make sure that part of course is very tight so that all of the competitors can't get through with a perfect score!!) **Fun event.**

Please keep in mind that **“timed events” are not** covered by our insurance policy, however MOST timed events can be modified to fit into the fun event category. If you have questions, or need help modifying your event, just let us know!!!
