



**WHAT:** The Wolfslide Trail Ride is a bi-annual event that hosts off road enthusiasts on 2-wheel dirt bikes, ATVs, and side by sides. It is not a race. It is a marked, one way, enduro style off road course that consists of approximately 50 miles of total trail length. Over the years it has become THE premier, off-road event in the southeast and covered by national industry media.

**WHO:** Riders of all ages and skill levels, from young beginners to experienced vets, attend The Wolfslide Trail Ride. Hosting approximately 600 participants, it is not uncommon to see 3 generations of families attending; spending anywhere from 3-5 days riding, camping, hanging out, and enjoying everything the experience has to offer.

**WHERE:** This event takes place at Seven Springs Lodge, home of the nationally recognized Rattlesnake Saloon. Seven Springs Lodge is nestled in the hills of northwest Alabama outside of Tuscumbia. Riders completely fill all 120 available camper hookups where they can relax around the campfire and share stories from their day on the trails.

**WHEN:** The event happens twice a year, usually in May and Nov. It is a 3-day event that typically sees attendees spending 3-5 days at the facility. The atmosphere is family friendly, and the promoter goes to great lengths to ensure EVERYONE is afforded a safe, relaxing, and inclusive environment.

**WHY:**

History

Out of sheer passion for the sport and a desire to host a safe event for enthusiasts of all skill levels, Wolf Slide Trail Ride is the brainchild of promotor Scott Voorheis. So, in partnership with 7 Springs Lodge owner, Danny Foster, and the help of a few volunteers, the first event was held in Aug. 2007. With average high temperatures of 96 degrees on that weekend in Alabama, there was a total of 9 paying riders. However, Scott held steadfast to his vision, and remained committed to his goal.

For the first several years, the event grew steadily but slowly. Eventually, word began to get out. Wolf Slide Trail Ride developed a reputation for providing extremes on each end of the spectrum. It encompasses the largest variety of terrain for any event of its kind. Meaning, it has some of the most challenging terrain for the experienced "extreme" riders, as well as some of the easiest for the novice riders, and everything in between.

Once the reputation was established, there was no stopping the success. With the help of a small group of committed volunteer enthusiasts, Wolf Slide Trail Ride has become the premiere event of its kind. While not the largest, by a very small margin, it has the most loyal attendance group, and is known for being the most fun and best managed trail ride anywhere. There is simply not a better atmosphere at any other event out there.
